Applying for Grants	Do you have grant writing experience? We'd love someone to assist us from time to time	Ad Hoc
Ebay/Online Seller	Are you an experienced ebayer? We get some very unusual items in our OpShop & sometimes think we would raise more funds selling items online and would love some help with this	Ad Hoc When it suits you/flexible
Social Media	We'd love to have a more co-ordinated approach to our social media and some help from someone with some experience in this area would be fantastic.	When it suits you/flexible
IT	WE are looking for an IT person to assist us with general ongoing maintenance, upgrades, problem solving etc	Approx once/fortnight
Volunteer Co-ordinator	Assist us with talking to potential volunteers, explaining roles, processing paperwork and putting rosters in place	Approx once/fortnight
Cleaner	General cleaning required for our OpShop, office and community centre	Weekly
Youthwork Assistant	A casual role to assist our youth worker with running school holiday programs	Days- during school holidays
OpShop volunteer	3 hourly shifts available from 10-1 or 1-4pm, Monday to Friday and Saturday mornings. Also roles for sorting donated items.	Weekdays & Saturday morning
Playgroup volunteer	Assist our playgroup co-ordinator and other volunteers to run our playgroups on Tues and Wed mornings. A variety of roles avail.	Tues & Wed 9.30-12.30
Community dinner volunteer	Help out with our community dinners to feed those who are homeless or struggling. Checking people in, heating meals, serving, making coffee, chatting to our visitors – a range of tasks involved. Whatever you feel comfortable with.	Weeknight evenings from approx. 5-7pm
Community dinner cook	Each night we serve approximately 40 people and ask that you cook approx. 20 desserts or main courses for those in need. Can be dropped off on the day or the day before the meals are required. We are sometimes also on the lookout for people to cook in house on a Thursday night from items that have been donated.	Once a month on a weeknight
Driver – Second Bite Food Collection	This role is available on Mondays & Thursdays & involves driving the small van to collect food items from local supermarkets. This role involves some carrying and heavy lifting.	Monday and Thursdays approx. 1-3pm
Food Sorter	Our current team could do with an extra pair of hands to help sort our food that is collected through Second Bite into boxes to assist those in need.	Thursdays approx. 1.30-3.30/4 pm
